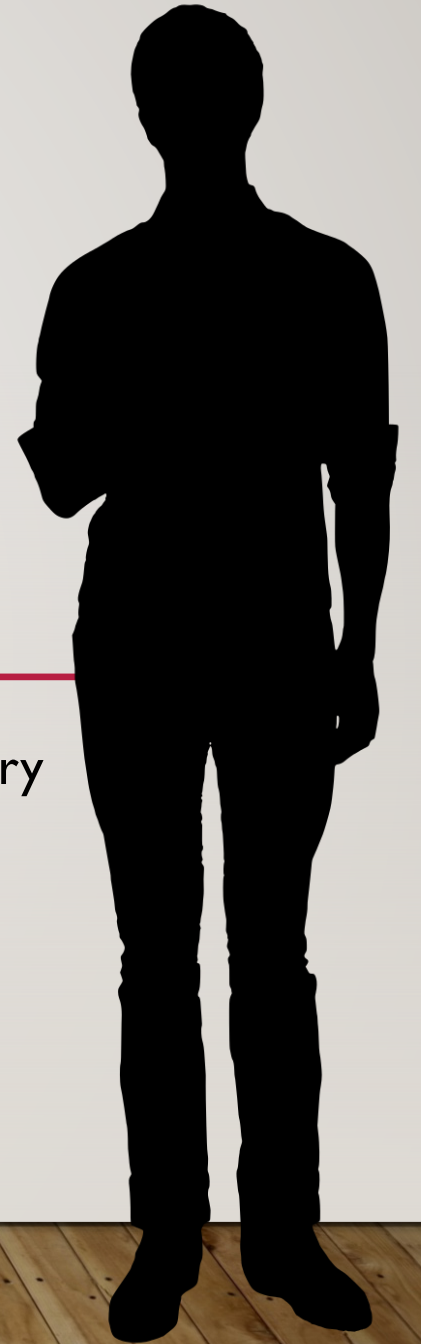


WHO IS THIS?

Preparing and doing an interview with a celebrity from the other country



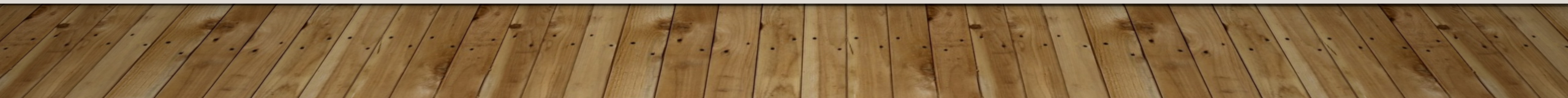
ANALYZING AN INTERVIEW

- Watch the interview with Britney Spears. Think about the following questions while watching it and take some notes:

What do you like and what not? What do you think about the questions that the interviewer asks? What is maybe special about them?

- Discuss your answers with the rest of the class.

PREPARATION FOR THE INTERVIEW

- Think about some questions that you can ask a celebrity in an interview and then write seven of them down.
- TIP: Let your curiosity lead you. Ask about things that you really want to know, and you are interested in. Avoid yes/no questions, since the answers may be very short and would not lead to a richer further subject. If you choose yes/no questions, ask your interview partner to explain their answer.

PREPARATION FOR THE INTERVIEW

- On the following slide you will find some example questions.
- **IMPORTANT:** These questions are guiding questions, examples for you to use and rephrase. You are not allowed to use more than 3 of these exact questions. You should be creative and come up with your own questions.

EXAMPLES FOR GUIDING QUESTIONS

- What is the greatest thing you achieved in life?
- What do you do for a living?
- What is your life motto?
- If you could, would you turn back time to change something? What would you change?
- What are your future projects?
- Please describe an average day of yours.
- What advice do you have for your fans?
- What makes you smile?
- What makes you scared?

Some of the questions have some personal sense to them. It makes the interview richer, and more interesting.

YOUR CELEBRITY

- Pick a famous person from the other country. Your teacher will let you pick a note with the name of the person (e.g. from a hat).
- Do a little research on your person and write down some basic information (e.g. age, job, known for what, etc.). Think about how your celebrity would answer the questions you prepared.
- Make a little poster with the information about your celebrity on Padlet. Be creative.

THE INTERVIEW (IN COOPERATION WITH THE OTHER CLASS)

- Now we will have a Zoom Meeting with the other class.
- Form groups of six students, three from each country. Your teacher will tell you in which group you are. Then, your teacher will put you in a Breakout Room with your group.
- Interview each other. One of you acts as the interviewer and the other one as the celebrity they picked. Then you switch roles. Use the questions you prepared.
